Directions to the Brandywine Town Center Meeting Hall

The meeting hall is a stand-alone building, removed from the commercial area, with a large glass dome on top.

From Route 202 Southbound: Shortly after crossing into Delaware on Route 202 southbound, turn left onto Naamans Road at the intersection bounded by an Exxon station and the Days Inn (old Tally Ho). At the second light, turn left into the Brandywine Town Center (You will see a large Target store) and follow the outer parking lot road right to the meeting hall.

From I-95 Northbound and 202 Northbound: Take Exit 8 Concord Pike North. Just beyond Concord Mall at the Days Inn, turn right onto Naamans Road and follow the directions above.

From I-95 Southbound: Take the I-495 and Naamans Road exit just after passing into Delaware. Take Naamans Road westbound. After passing Grubb Road, you will take the next right into Brandywine Town Center. Look for the meeting center described above but you will go left on the circling road.

Directions to Anson B. Nixon Park

Headed south on Route 1 in PA, take the Kennett Square exit and head into town on State Street. Turn right onto Walnut Road, near the bottom of the hill. (The Kennett Square YMCA is opposite.) You will soon see the sign for the Anson B. Nixon Park on the left. Park in the central parking lot and walk to the appropriate pavilion in the woods. People coming through Kennett Square from the opposite direction on Cypress St. can take the first street on the left after the YMCA, go 1 block, and cross over State St. onto Walnut Road.

Directions to Nature's Way Nursery

Take US-202 N and/or PA-100 N. Enter the Pennsylvania Turnpike Westbound (Toll). Go about 65 miles. Take exit number 19, toward I-283 East Harrisburg, Hershey. Follow signs for I-81 N. Take exit number 72B toward Linglestown. You will be on North Mountain Road. Go one mile to the "town square." At the circle and flagpole, turn right onto Linglestown Road. In 1.5 miles you will see a yellow sign on the left for Nature's Way. Turn left into Nature's Way. Total distance about 100 miles. Estimated Time about 2 hours.
